Kate received third place in the Chippewa Valley Symphony's 2009 Young Artist Competition and first honorable mention in the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra's 2009 Young Artist Competition. Twice Kate was named a winner of the Wisconsin Music Teachers' Association Badger competition. She has performed in other competitions including the LaCrosse Symphony's Rising Stars Concerto Competition. Kate studies piano with Dr. Barbara Young.

Kate also studies harp, and has performed as principal harpist with the Wisconsin High School State Honors Orchestra in 2008 and 2009. In 2009 Kate received an Exemplary Solo Award for her class A harp solo at the Wisconsin School Music Association's State Solo and Ensemble Festival. Kate acts as principal harpist with the Chippewa Valley Youth Symphony and the Eau Claire Memorial High School Orchestra. She performs with the Chippewa Valley Symphony and in chamber ensembles.

In addition to music, Kate enjoys math competitions, cross-country running, and historical research. She hopes to pursue a career in harp performance.
